

Chester Le Community Mural

The Chester Le Mural is an exciting artistic venture seeing residents of the Chester Le community working in unison with a mural artist to create an amazing art piece. The Chester Le community backs unto Victoria Park Avenue and is supported by a sound barrier wall expanding the entire length of the complex. This wall stands as the canvas for the Chester Le Mural. The mural team consists of an artist, and a mural worker who leads a team of Chester Le youths hired to work on the art from inception to unveiling.



There were a series of community consultations both at the residents' doors and through gatherings at the Chester Le Community Corner. The consultations allowed community members an active role and a sense of ownership in the creation of the mural, offering artistic suggestions of what is important to and is representative of the Chester Le Community in order to build an inclusive narrative. There is much excitement around the mural project and anticipation of the end results.



Throughout the community consultations, major themes emerged including: family, diversity, community, and nature. These themes then evolved with the mural group members into a dynamic vision of the four seasons with Canadian animals to be inclusive of all four themes. The animals were selected very carefully to represent those from the community.
