<p><b>Healthy Meal and Active Play (0-6 Years):</b> This interactive program enhances and promotes healthy eating and active play. Children will learn new sounds, words, patterns through music and enjoy learning how to move and control their bodies...sway, swing, and dance.</p>	<p><b>Creative Play (0-6 years):</b> Creative Play encourages creative expression through play-based learning for children 0-6 years with their parents or caregivers. This program focuses on children's early development and includes cognitive, language and psycho-social activities.</p>
<p><b>EarlyON drop in (0-6 years):</b> This program offers opportunities for caregivers and families to come with their children and enjoy a range of programs and activities. There will be a variety of programs including arts and crafts, sensory activities for development, school readiness activities, circle time with songs and stories and healthy snacks.</p>	<p><b>Little Builders with Lego (3-6 Years Old)</b> Come and enjoy our Lego themed learning. We will provide a variety of Lego bricks. This activity is great for fine motor skill along with creativity, team work, problem solving, mathematical and analytical skills, lateral thinking, planning skills, communication, self-esteem, while having fun.</p>	<p><b>Family time (0-6 Years Old)</b> Family time encourages children to come together with their parents/caregivers and interact through play-based learning for children 0-6. Program will include team building activities and games that support children and family. This program focuses on children's early development and includes cognitive, language and psycho-social activities.
