Our knowledgeable & highly experienced staff will provide you the following services for FREE:

- Services provided FREE of cost to newcomers who are Permanent Residents, Live-in Caregivers, Convention Refugees & Protected Persons
- One-on-one counseling to help newcomers in their settlement and integration process
- Monthly newcomer orientation sessions (ie. access to government benefits, updates on immigration policies & applications, job search workshops, mental health, financial literacy, children's programs and services, scholarship programs, etc.)
- Itinerant services to provide settlement and outreach services off-site (selected branches of the Toronto Public Library, City of Toronto Community Recreation Centre, Family Health Clinic, & the Scarborough General Hospital)
- Guidance in filling out forms on application for permanent residence card, OHIP, Canadian Citizenship, Child Tax Benefit, Social Housing, Welcome Policy, Kids Computer, Trillium Drug Benefit, etc.
- Information and referral related to upgrading of skills, language assessment, bridging program, credentials assessment, translation services, recreation programs, employment & legal services, etc.
- Canadian Citizenship Test Preparation Workshops & practice test questions; one-on-one coaching sessions
- Health and wellness program for parents, adults, and seniors
- Referral to food bank, free furniture, and other community support services
- Weekly social activities for seniors at the Seniors' Cafe (connect seniors with other seniors to prevent social isolation, exercise activities, monthly workshops)
- Building connections for newcomers through community events
- Summer program for the newcomer youth
- Volunteer and student placement opportunities for the newcomers
- Access to telephone, computer, printer, & fax
