SYRIAN NEWCOMERS PROJECT

The Syrian Newcomer Project is a unique and exciting Project that will empower 500 Syrian newcomers to rebuild their lives in Canada through skills training and acquiring certifications and licenses to practice selected occupations in Ontario. These skills training will be provided in parallel with other supports provided to the Syrian newcomers such as connecting them with employment supports, language programs, educational opportunities, professional networks, and community connections. The Project will involve a mentorship component and will offer financial literacy support to promote socio-economic inclusion and long-term financial security.

FREE OR SUBSIDIZED COST FOR SKILLS TRAINING OR LICENSING:

Certificate or Cost of Training Provided: Cash Register Training * Customer Service Training * Food Handling Program * First-Aid CPR Training

MENTORSHIP & EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT

We will match you with a mentor who is working in an occupation similar to what you are looking for. We aim to connect you to a wider professional or occupational network. We will connect you with an employment agency that will provide intensive support to help you connect with employment opportunities.

FINANCIAL EMPOWERMENT

We will offer support to access key entitlements of income support. We will offer support filling up application forms on Canada Child Benefit/ GST/HST, opening bank account, income tax filing, managing debt, managing personal resources, accessing savings, asset building opportunities and protection from financial fraud and abuse.
